READ BEFORE THE INSTALLATION



1. The use of ladders and scaffolding in elevated work areas is inherently dangerous. To prevent falling, use safety equipment and comply with the manufacturer's suggestions regarding safety.
2. Use extreme caution when working around the roof opening to prevent falling and personal injury.
3. All materials placed on the roof should be secured to prevent them falling or sliding down.
4. Roofing work should not be carried out during strong winds, storms, rains, and other unfavorable atmospheric conditions such as frost and ice.
5. The weight of windows varies, therefore transportation to the installation spot and installation should be done with as many people necessary to avoid accidents. Always apply proper lifting techniques.
6. Carefully handle metal elements of the skylight and flashing, mind sharp edges.
7. Persons well familiar with their safe use can only use tools required for installation. Never allow unqualified persons to use power or hand tools. Incorrect use of hand and power tools can result in personal injury and/or damage to the product. Comply with tools manufacturer suggestions regarding safety and use.
8. Always wear safety goggles and gloves.
9. Make sure that pipes and electrical wires in the existing roof will not be cut during installation of the product.
10. While cutting the opening use block sections to avoid injury or damage caused by falling elements. Stay clear of the cutting area and pay attention to placement of hands while cutting. Never allow cut out elements, tools and other materials to fall down the hole.
11. Consult with an architect, engineer or the roof manufacturer before cutting or removing rafters, battens or other elements of roof construction.
12. For existing roofs, remove sufficient roofing material to fit the appropriate flashing. Also remove nails, screws and other objects which may lead to cutting tool damage and personal injury.
